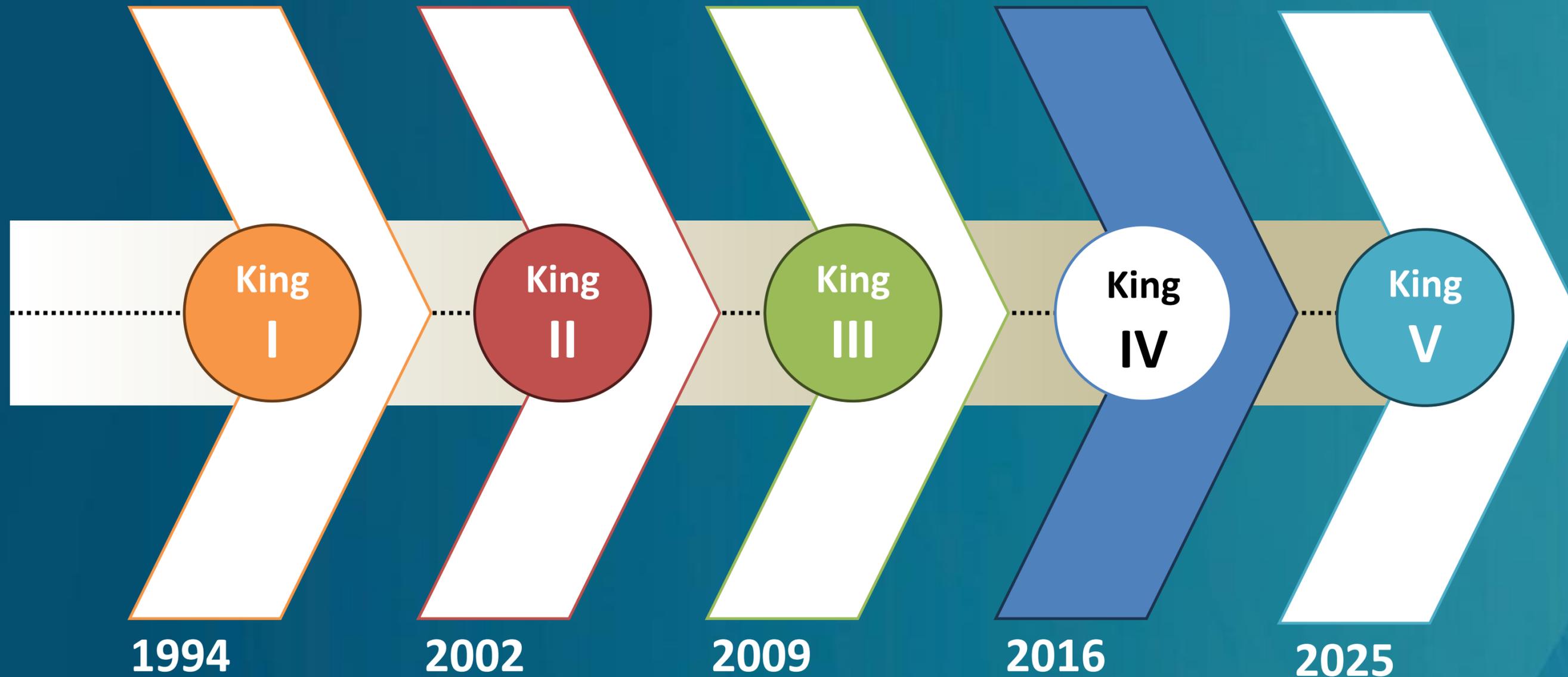

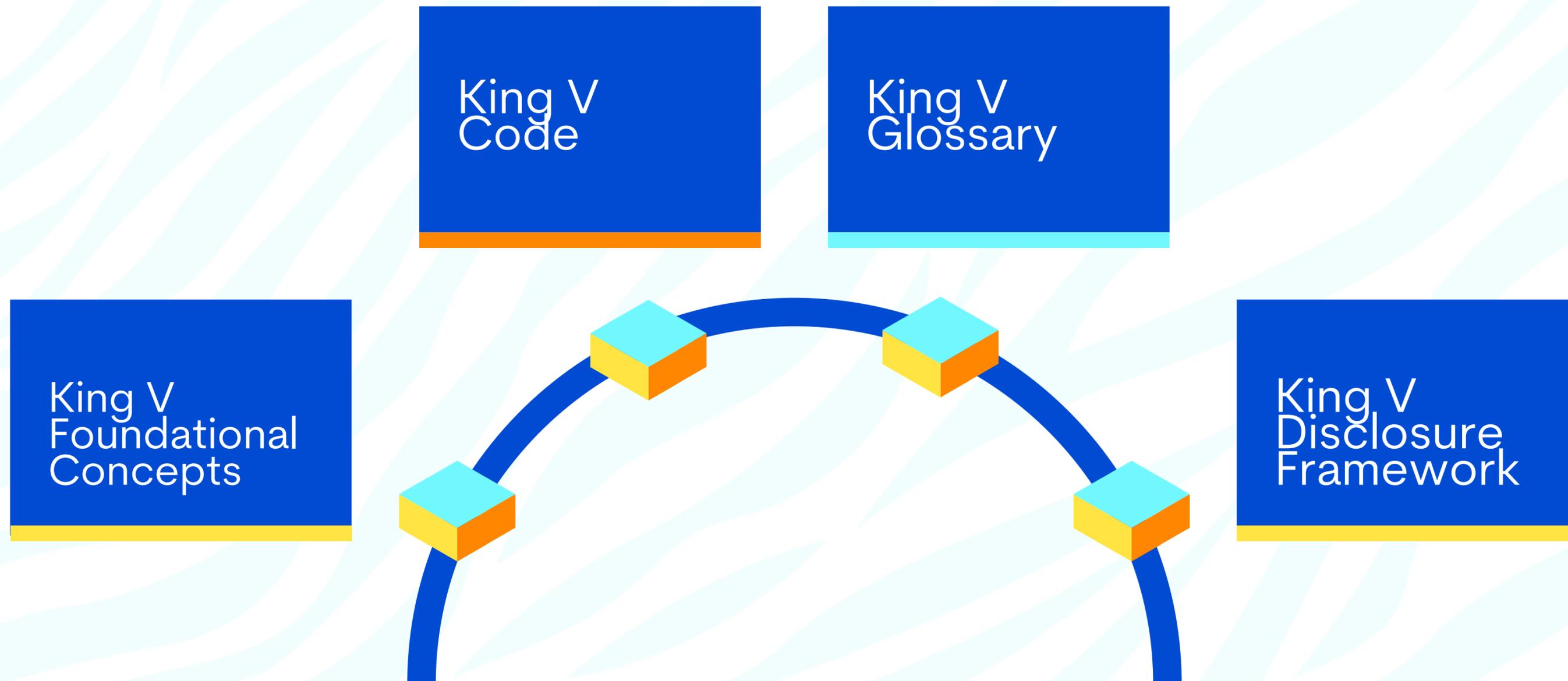


# King V™\* definition of governance

The exercise of ethical and effective leadership by the governing body towards the achievement of certain governance outcomes for the organisation within its economic, social and environmental context.

# Structure of King V

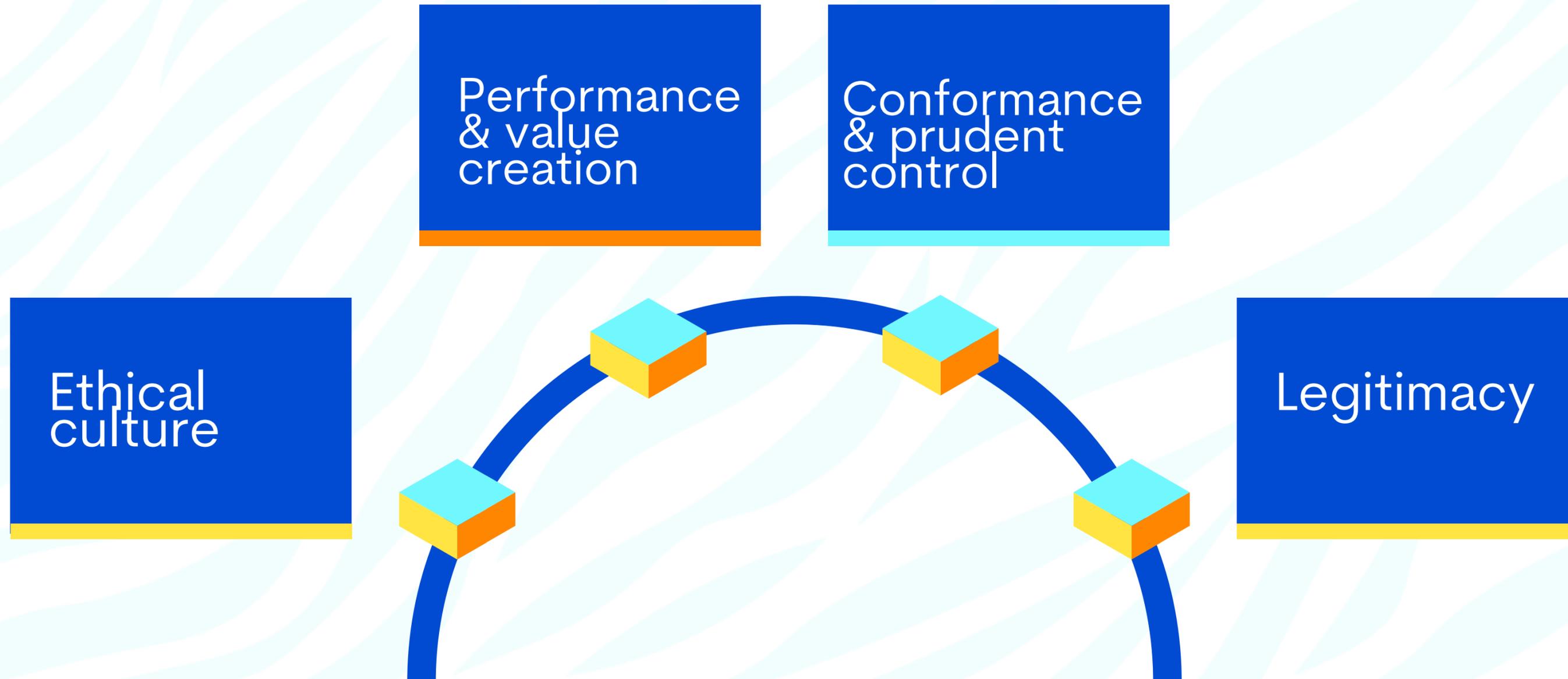


## Voluntary code - applies to a range of organisations

- company
- retirement fund
- non-profit organisation
- state-owned entity
- municipality
- medical scheme
- public higher education institution



# 4 Governance outcomes



- **Ethical Culture:**

The shared values, beliefs and practices within the organisation that promote ethical behaviour and decision making.

- **Performance and Value Creation:**

Organisational performance that creates value in a sustainable manner within the organisation's economic, social and environmental context.



# Governance Outcomes

- **Conformance and Prudent Control:**

Adherence by the organisation to the spirit and intent of laws and the policies, non-binding rules, codes and standards as adopted by the organisation as well as the establishment of an effective system of internal controls and accountability mechanisms.

- **Legitimacy:**

The social license to operate that the organisation has acquired, in addition to its formal legal right or license to operate, through transparently demonstrating its trustworthiness and responsible corporate citizenship.

# Key takeouts

## New – Technology Governance Elevated

Data and IT oversight: With digital transformation, King V expands board responsibilities for governing information and technology. This includes oversight of data management, cybersecurity, and the ethical use of emerging technology like AI. Boards are expected to ensure tech supports strategy and is managed with proper security and compliance measures.

# | Implementation in practice

- A gap analysis is required against King V, specifically as to whether there are matters requiring a change in focus and/or enhancement.
- This gap analysis should be performed per practice as well as per related disclosure requirement.
- Changes required for King IV compliant companies are likely to be minimal but may require an update to governance artefacts such as Committee Terms of Reference/Mandates and Group Governance Frameworks.
